

ST. ANNES CRICKET CLUB COMMITTEE PROPOSAL TO AGM

Proposal

The committee of management propose that the Club constitution and rules are reviewed and amended accordingly to enable the Club to operate in an effective and safe manner in today's environment.

This process will take place over the next 12 months and resulting proposed rule changes will be presented to the membership in the 2023 AGM for their ratification.

No further rules changes will be made until the AGM of 2023, with the exception of the following proposed rule changes which is as a requirement of ECB and Club mark regulations.

Rule 2 to be changed as follows:-

- a) To encourage cricket and other sports or pastimes of which the Committee of management shall approve, support and encourage.
- b) To be a member of or affiliated to any League or Association for the promotion of cricket.
- c) To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club.
- d) To ensure that all present and future member receive fair and equal treatment.
- e) To adopt and implement the English and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) Safe hands- Crickets Policy for Safeguarding Children and any future versions of the policy. The club must also have a separate club safeguarding policy statement, as required by the ECB. All new and existing members must be aware of Safeguarding procedures.
- f) To adopt and implement the ECB Cricket Inclusion and Diversity Policy and any future versions of this policy.
- g) To adopt and implement the ECB Cricket Anti-Discrimination Code and any future versions of this policy.
- h) To ensure that members abide by the ECB Code of Conduct which incorporates the Spirit of Cricket and the Laws of Cricket, the rules and regulations of the leagues the club may be a member of, St. Annes Cricket Club Rules and Code of Conducts which are on the Club website.

Note: There is a numbering error in the current Club rules as there are two rule 2's. It is intended that the existing second rule 2 be wholly incorporated into rule 3.
