### Proposed amendments to St Annes CC rules

The purpose of the proposed amendments to the club rules (written in red) is to update them to reflect ECB and club mark requirements.

1. The Committee of Management shall make amendments to rule 2 **The objectives of the club** and rule 3
2. The Committee of Management shall remove rules 15, 28 and 29 as they will be incorporated into rule 2
3. The Committee of management shall incorporate part of rule 2 The Executives into rule 3 **The Committee of Management shall consist of etc**
4. The Executive will agree to the addition of other positions to the committee as described below,

### Details

#### 2. **The objectives of the club will be: -**

- To encourage cricket and other sports or pastimes of which the Committee of management shall approve, **support and encourage.**
- To be a member of or affiliated to any League or Association for the promotion of cricket.
- **To ensure a duty of care to all members of the Club**
- **To ensure that all present and future members receive fair and equal treatment**
- **To adopt and implement the English and Wales Cricket Board (ECB) Safe hands- Crickets Policy for Safeguarding Children and any future versions of the policy. The club must also have a separate club safeguarding policy statement, as required by the ECB. All new and existing members must be aware of Safeguarding procedures**
- **To adopt and implement the ECB Cricket Inclusion and Diversity Policy and any future versions of the policy.**
- **To adopt and implement the ECB Cricket Anti-Discrimination Code and any future versions of this policy.**
- **To ensure that members abide by the ECB Code of Conduct which incorporates the Spirit of Cricket and the Laws of Cricket, the rules and regulations of the leagues the club maybe a member of, St Annes Cricket Club Rules and Code of Conducts which are on the club website.**

**3. The Executives of the Club** shall be the President, Chairman, Vice Chairman and Secretary, to be elected by and from the cricketing body which comprises of the Adult Players, Life Members, Vice Presidents, Patrons and Serving Committee Members. They shall be elected at each Annual General Meeting. They shall hold office until the next Annual General Meeting when they shall retire, but shall be eligible for re-election from

year to year and to be known as the Executive Body of the Club. All elected officials must be over the age of eighteen years.

**The Committee of Management** shall consist of the Executives and cricket chairman, Subscription secretary, **safeguarding officer, social media and website manager, treasurer, junior representative, player's representative, and or other positions that the Executive wishes to include on the committee**, to be elected at the AGM in the same manner as the Executive. The Executive shall have the power to co-opt and fill any casual vacancy.

Remove rules 15, 28 and 29 as they will be incorporated into rule 2 as described above

15. The Laws of the game of Cricket as settled by the Marylebone Cricket Club shall be adhered to, together with the rules and regulations of the Leagues of which the Club may be a member.
  
28. The Club will adopt and implement the ECB 'Safe Hands – Welfare of Young People in Cricket' Policy together with the ECB Club inclusion and diversity policy. All new and existing members must be made aware of child welfare and protection procedures. Notices will be displayed on the club premises to cover the requirements.
29. The Club has adopted the ECB Club Inclusion and Diversity Policy and adhere to its principles and its guidelines.
